


### **Art Scavenger Hunt**


- 1) **Nature's Palette:** Find a painting that features a landscape. Describe the colors used and what season it represents.
- 2) **Portrait of a Time:** Look for a portrait painting. Who is the subject? What do their expressions and clothing tell you about the era they lived in?
- 3) **Still Life Story:** Locate a still life painting. What objects are depicted? What do you think the artist wanted to convey with these items?
- 4) **Movement in Art:** Identify a painting that captures motion. What elements indicate movement? Describe the scene and the emotions it evokes.
- 5) **Cultural Reflection:** Find an artwork that represents a specific culture or tradition. What symbols or motifs are present, and what do they signify?
- 6) **Historic Moments:** Discover a painting that depicts a historical event. What event is it illustrating? What details in the artwork help tell the story?
- 7) **Art and Emotion:** Choose a painting that evokes a strong emotion. Describe the artwork and explain why it resonates with you.
- 8) **Artist's Signature:** Locate a painting and find the artist's signature. What can you learn about the artist from their signature or style?




### **Past Perfect Scavenger Hunt**


On the Hoyt Sherman Place website, click the gallery tab to view the online collections through Past Perfect prior to or after your visit. Below you find questions pertaining to pieces of the collection. Use the clues to identify and find the object in our collection.

1)	<b>Paintings.</b> There is a painting called "The Cup of Tea". Copy and paste the description for it in Past Perfect.
2)	<b>Sculpture.</b> Des Moines Women's Club members traveled to the 1893 Chicago World's Fair and purchased our first piece, a bronze statue titled "Jeanne D'Arc". What is the catalog number for this piece?
3)	<b>Byers Collection.</b> Four chests were given to the DMWC in 1911, by Byers, who referred to them as Swiss Wedding Chests. What is the length, width, and height of the Carved Wood Cassone Chest?
4)	<b>Paintings.</b> There is a portrait of Hoyt Sherman from 1903 that hangs above the fireplace in the library. Who was the artist?
5)	<b>Sculpture.</b> In the collection how many sculptures are there of Venus, the Roman Goddess of love, beauty, and prosperity?
6)	Byers Collection. What is the title of the painting featuring a lake in Italy?












#### Hoyt Sherman Place Mansion, Art Gallery & Theater Crossword Puzzle
